P G DEPARTMENT OF HOME SCIENCE

The academic year 2022 -23 began with election of the chairperson and secretary of the association. Ms.Haritha L of II PG was elected as the president and Ms. Sreelekshmi of 5th semester BSc was elected as the Secretary.

Our Department organised an International Webinar on "Caring for persons with Dementia" on 6th December 2022, as a part of Interdisciplinary International webinar series "ECLECTICS 2022" organised by our College and IQAC, from 21st to 30th May, 2021. The Resource person for the webinar were **Dr. Farzana Chaze** and **Dr Nellie Groenenberg**, both are Faculties of Applied Health and Community Studies, Sheridan College, Ontario, Canada.

The PG Department of Home Science of Sree Narayana College for Women, Kollam, collaborated with Fevicryl, Pidilite Industries Limited to organize a twelve-day, three-month workshop for the students of Sree Narayana College for Women . 
Ms Jisha S was allotted in Zoology as laboratory Assistant

To instigate the drive towards research in the young minds, Department of Chemistry, SN college for women, Kollam in association with Institute Innovation Council (IIC) & Research Committee has conducted an invited talk on "Conducting polymers for Plastic Electronics" on 14 October 2022. The talk was headed by Dr. Somanathan, retired deputy director and head of polymer science. and tech dept. at central leather research institute, Chennai. The talk covers the basics of electrically conducting polymers/ polymeric semiconductors, Polymers for opto electronic devices, displays, white leds for solid state lighting, polymeric LEds for backlight in

LCD, solar cell, Some focus on polymeric magnets, Organic LED lasers and biosensors. The expert have more than 38 years' experience in the structure (molecular –micro-(supra molecular) macro)- property relations in polymeric materials. More than 90 publications in international journal of repute and peer reviewed International proceedings. 5 Indian patents and one American, U.K. and Germany patent. The basic understanding of structure- property relationships in polymers is being utilized in solving the problems referred to by the industries. Different types of polymers were synthesized and the polymeric structure with electrical, electronic, thermal and mechanical properties was studied in detail depending on the application of these polymers for varied applications. The structures include molecular, micro and macro structures, which are related to different properties of simulated end use application.
